Offered in two interpretations, the CIC $39\,\mathrm{mm}$ Longitude invites two distinct journeys.

Each reflection recalls the calm of a tranquil sea at dawn, where silence is interrupted only by the steady heartbeat of the mechanical movement. The cobalt blue dial evokes the clear, vibrant skies of a sunny day at sea, where sailors navigate with confidence. Beyond its maritime inspiration, cobalt blue symbolizes confidence in navigating, trust, stability, and calmness—in this timepiece, it becomes more than a color, a state of mind.

In a world where everything accelerates, Lederer chooses patience and rarity. The CIC 39 mm Longitude is limited to only 24 pieces, divided into two extremely exclusive series of 12, one with the white dial, one with the cobalt blue dial.

This number is no coincidence. It echoes the 24 hours that pace our daily lives, the 24 time zones that connect continents, the 24 imaginary meridians that structure our planet and guide sailors. Each piece thus becomes

a fragment of a universal cycle, an intimate compass, a faithful companion on the journey through days and nights.

All watches are COSC-certified, an indisputable symbol of precision and reliability. This commitment to excellence affirms the CIC 39 mm Longitude's vocation: to embody the essence of the finest marine chronometers, all within an elegant and contemporary format.



AN EXCEPTIONAL MECHANICS IN SERVICE OF TIME

At the heart of the CIC 39 mm Longitude beats the LEDERER movement with a double detent escapement, reinforced by two remontoirs d'égalité. A true mechanical masterpiece, this patented caliber reduces energy loss and ensures perfect regularity, even under the most extreme conditions.

The small seconds positioned between 6 and 9 o'clock, a nod to historical observatory dials, reinforces its kinship with the CIC 44 Triple Certified Observatory

Chronometer while adding a touch of modernity. The finishes, entirely handmade, reveal an exceptional level of care: fine satin finishing, mirror-polished anglage, pearled surfaces, and deep engravings testify to an artisanal savoir-faire pushed to its absolute limits.

Available in a 39 mm case, perfectly proportioned, the CIC 39 mm Longitude fits elegantly on any wrist. Its fluid curves and contained thickness guarantee optimal comfort, worthy of a modern navigation instrument.
